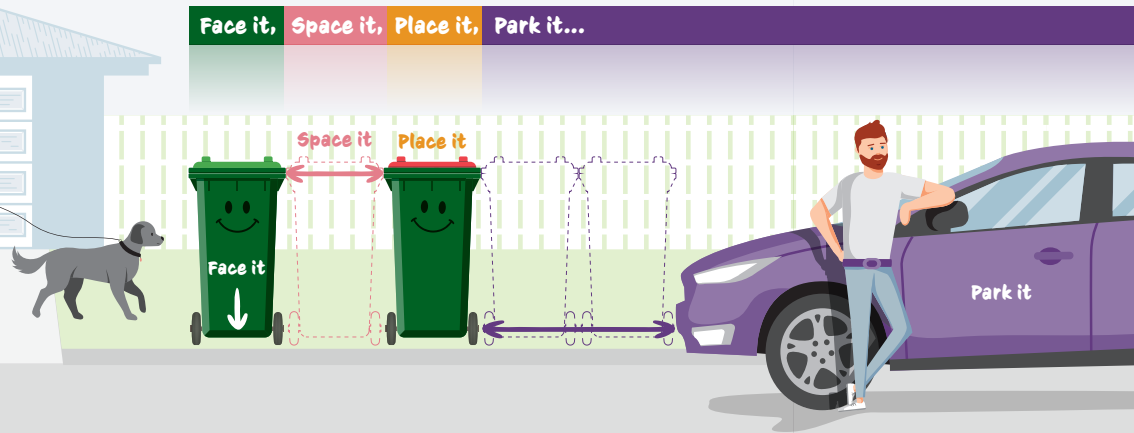


What to do with your car on collection days

You know how to **Face it**, **Space it**, **Place it** –
but do you know how to **Park it**?



What to do with your car on collection days

Leave enough space: Ensure that there is at least one metre of space between your bin and any parked cars, this will allow the mechanical arm of the waste truck to pick up the bin without any hindrance.

Avoid obstructions: Make sure that your bin is not placed under a tree or any other overhead obstruction. Also, ensure that your bin is at least one metre away from power poles, street signs, or objects that may hinder pick-up.

Mind the space when you park or place: Keep the area around your bin clear of any obstructions, such as parked cars, so that the waste truck can easily access it.

Do not park in prohibited areas: Do not park your car in areas where stopping of motor vehicles is prohibited under the Road Rules. This will ensure that the waste truck can easily navigate through the narrow streets.

Dead end street parking: To allow the waste truck to manoeuvre safely around the Cul de Sac or dead end street, park your car in your driveway on the day of bin service.

Follow local guidelines: Check with council for any specific guidelines or regulations regarding parking and bin placement in narrow streets.
